**Call to Order** – Anthony Hanson called the meeting to order.

**Solicitation of ideas from the general public** – No input from the public was received by committee members. Anthony will visit with Doug Hanneman at the Leader regarding a potential editorial or letter to the editor.

**Community / Cultural Center** – Steve was contacted about a state-of-the-art performing arts center. This would be an item for future discussion.

**Baseball / Softball Fields** – Two fields could potentially be lost in 2013 due to storm water management issues at Linden Park. Brain M., Dolf, and Brian G. will be analyzing the current baseball and softball trends and evaluating field needs.

**Volunteer Coordinator** – The City continues to work on volunteer opportunities including volunteer job descriptions, expectations, training, recognition, etc. Dolf shared that PRCE volunteers contribute 7,000 hours a year in the form of coaching, weeding, tree counting, sidewalk inspecting, and other duties. Daron has presented the volunteer coordinator idea to school administration. K-5 has a lot of volunteers and are well managed; however, they are looking for ideas to increase Middle and High School volunteerism.

**Solicit Projects from ISD 423 / City** – The school district and the city continue to coordinate facility maintenance resources when possible. Ryan suggested combing not only public and private dollars but also people. Find the people who are passionate about specific projects and get them connected (i.e. the ice rink at Park Elementary is maintained by the neighborhood). A wish list of items that could be donated could be established. It was suggested the school district think about marketing their engineering equipment to small businesses for research and development work.

**Frequency of Meetings** – At this time, the group will continue to meet quarterly. Sub-groups are encouraged to meet between committee meetings if needed.

**Other** – Potential facility opportunities include the HTI Development Center and the former Burns Manor building. Discussion is taking place within the EDA (Economic Development Authority) about how to re-purpose those buildings.

**Next Meeting** – The next meeting will be July 18, 2012 from 3:30 to 5:30 pm, location to be determined.
