HUTCHINSON SCHOOL DISTRICT ACTIVITIES CHECK LIST AND FEES

Dear Parents:

Your son/daughter has indicated a desire to participate in our activities program. The following steps must be taken before equipment can be issued.

- ✓ Must have a **PHYSICAL EXAMINATION** at the student's expense once every three years. **Copy of physical must be on file in the High School/Middle schools nurse's office.**
- ✓ Must have **HHS/MS ELIGIBILITY FORM AND MSHSL ANNUAL HEALTH QUESTIONNAIRE** completed and signed by the parents and the athlete once each year.
- ✓ All participants and parents are to study and sign the **MSHSL ELIGIBILITY STATEMENT**. It must be on file with the Director of Student Activities.
 - a. Each family will be provided with a set of school rules and regulations when a student from that family fills out his/her forms for participation. All rules should be read and remembered, especially the rule that states:

A STUDENT MUST BE IN SCHOOL THE ENTIRE DAY TO TAKE PART IN AN EXTRA-CURRICULAR PRACTICE OR CONTEST THAT DAY.

- ✓ Must provide insurance coverage for the student by either of the following methods:
 - a. **PRIVATE HEALTH AND HOSPITAL INSURANCE.**
 - b. Athletic insurance is available. Forms are available in the high school office.

STUDENT ACTIVITY FEES:

- a. Each student will be charged an equipment fee for any activity he/she is participating in.
- b. The participation fees charged for this school year will be:

- c. All sixth, seventh, and eighth grade participants will pay **\$100.00** fee per sport, with the exception of hockey. If a MS student is playing on JV/Varsity level they will continue to pay the MS activity fee for that sport. The fee for high school hockey will be \$160.00.
- d. **Fine Arts Fees is \$70.00**
- e. A family cap of **\$450.00** is available for activity fees. The parents or guardians of participants must keep track of the fees paid through out the year and are required to pay up to \$450.00 each year. ***Club activities fees do not qualify towards the family cap such as: Key Club, Link Crew, Trap Shooting, FFA, etc.***
- f. **Fee Reimbursement-** should participant become injured a prorated refund will be issued, should participant be cut a full refund will be issued, should participant quit no refund will be issued.
- g. **School uniforms and/or equipment** - any uniforms and/or equipment not returned within two weeks after completion of activity will result in the replacement of uniform and/or equipment at the student's expense.

- h. No student will be denied participation in any activity due to inability to pay the activity fee. For information regarding the confidential waiving of fees, a student should contact Mr. Szymanski (320) 234-2698 or Mrs. Mittelsteadt 234-2647.
