## Special Olympics-Track and Field

Spring is here, and we are excited to begin the *2022 Special Olympics Track and Field Season*! Hutchinson Public School's Special Olympics Track Program is available for students ages 8-21 (grade 3, and at least 8 years old). Mona Hjerpe will serve as the head coach.

Practices will be held on *Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:00 p.m.-4:15 p.m.*, with the first practice on *Tuesday, April 19<sup>th</sup>*. Practice locations will either be indoors (at NCCS) or outdoors at the HHS track. Elementary-aged participants are invited to join practice at 3:30, or as soon as they are able to arrive after school with a parent/guardian. The cost for each student-athlete is \$30. No one will be turned away due to inability to pay.

If your child is **new** to Hutch Tigers Special Olympics, please complete the following: **1)** Track and Field Registration form, **2)** Special Olympics Physical Form and Release, and submit a check for \$30 (made out to Hutchinson Public Schools). **Returning members** with current paperwork need only to turn in the **registration form and fee**. *All paperwork can be found online at:* http://www.isd43.org/district/activities/special-olympics/

Please Note: Student athletes must complete all required paperwork, including a current physical examination (included in the Application for Participation Form) and Official Special Olympics Release Form, <u>prior</u> to participation in practices or meets.

Please have your child at the practice site by 3:00 p.m., and have arrangements for someone to pick up by 4:15 p.m. Parents and group home staff are always welcome to attend practices, and are required if the student athlete is in need of 1 to 1 assistance.
