A student may receive .5 credits for each course successfully completed. Summer school will be held using a credit recovery model. Under this model, a student who had previously taken a course and didn't receive a passing grade will take a diagnostic test to determine which portion of that course he/she still needs to meet proficiency to achieve credit in the course. Course work based on this test will be created. Successful completion of the material will result in the credit marked as an "S" (Satisfactory) for the course grade. Not completing the material will result in an (U) Unsatisfactory for a grade. However, if the student would rather complete the whole course again to achieve a letter grade that holds GPA weight, he/she should inform his/her teacher of this desire and retake the entire course.

If a student has never taken the course before, he/she will complete the entire course under an independent study model to achieve credit and a letter grade, must be at least 16 years old, and put in at minimum 17 hours of seat time (time spent at summer school) per course.

During summer school, students must complete one course before beginning another. We ask that students attend every day until course work is complete. Because we are using an online system, students may also work on some of their course work at home at the teacher's discretion. Being absent for three consecutive days unexcused will result in an administrative conference and may result in loss of credit for the course and dropped enrollment from summer school.
