
## A New Year has Begun






















# Summer Lowdown

# Free Meals



#### Who:

All currently enrolled Hutchinson students are eligible for Free Meals.

#### When:

Monday, September 14th through December 22nd or until USDA funding ceases.

## Where:

In person students can get free breakfast and/or lunch while at school.

Distance Learners/Hybrid days families can order bundled free meals to pick up through our weekly order form sent via Campus Messenger or found on our website each Thursday.

#### Why:

The USDA extended a Nationwide waiver to allow schools to utilize funds from the Summer Feeding program through December 2020 or sooner if funding runs out. This funding gives free meals to all students.
