#### MORNING AT PARK ELEMENTARY

- □Drop-off Zones:
  - Busses drop off on Grove Street
  - Family drop off on Glen Street
  - Bicycles are locked to bike racks near 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue



- □Enter the building from 8:25-8:35 AM. No earlier than 8:25, please.
- □School starts at 8:35 AM
- ☐Breakfast is served in the classroom and is available for all students at no cost.
- □Video announcements are shown each day and posted on our website.
- □Call Park Elementary Office to report any student absences or tardies by 9 AM, if possible.
- □Children bring their own snack for snack time.

#### RESET ROOM and ACADEMIC SUPPORT ROOM

A student can become concerned and/or frustrated and they struggle to concentrate on learning until the problem has a solution. The Reset Room provides a child time to get refocused and ready to learn.

- The Reset Room is provided to students during school hours. A certified staff member will collaborate with the child to solve any problems and develop a proactive plans for the future.
- ☐ The Academic Support Room is staffed by a paraprofessional to help support students with academics from 11:30-1:30.

### SPECIALISTS













- □ Park has the following content areas in which Certified Specialists provide instruction:
  - ■Art, Music, Phy Ed, & STREAM (Science, Technology, Robotics, Engineering, Art, Mathematics)
- □2 day color cycle for Specialists that rotates throughout school year ■Example:

Red Day – Music and PE Blue Day – Art and STREAM

### ACADEMICS

- ■Math Resource Everyday Math
- □Reading Resource Read Side-by-Side and Guided Reading
- Homeroom teacher presents core subjects with differentiation. Grade 5 students will have a homeroom with multiple teachers depending on subject.
- □Homework: Reading and Math
  - ■Average of 20 minutes/night
  - ■Gold Take-Home Folder "Bring Back" pocket section provided for you. Students will receive these on the first day of school.
- □Social Studies and Science are integrated throughout the day.



# END OF DAY AT PARK ELEMENTARY

- ☐Bell rings at 3:15 PM
- □Classroom teacher escorts students to the exit door/bus
- ☐ Walkers assisted by Safety Patrol staff on northeast and southwest corners of the building.
- □If getting picked-up, students should meet their families by the office or outside, in front of the building
- □Bicyclists should wear helmets and walk their bike in the crosswalks with the help of Safety Patrol Adults
- □Students bring home Gold folders each day
- □After school activities are planned by Community Education

#### **ASSESSMENTS**

- □FastBridge are online computerized tests for Reading and Math
  - ■All students at Park are administered this Nationally Normed Assessment. Results will give us information based on how students do on a national basis.
- ☐Minnesota Comprehensive Assessments (MCAs)
  - ■Reading and Math MCAs are taken by students in grades 4 & 5 in April and early May
  - ■Science MCAs are taken by 5<sup>th</sup> grade students
  - ■MCA Assessments give us information on how we are doing compared to other students in Minnesota.
- □Local Assessments The following gives us information that we use to help us make instructional decisions for all of our students at Park.
  - ■Oral Reading Fluency
  - ■Math Fluency
  - ■Math Assessments
  - **■**Reading Benchmarks

## SAFE AND SECURE SCHOOLS

- Set-up your <u>Tiger Portal</u> account and check it frequently. Need assistance? Call the District Office at 320-587-2860.


